Applications are reviewed by the Board's Nominating Committee to assess candidates and determine eligibility. All new directors are elected by a majority vote of the current board. BOARD DIRECTOR RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Directors shall serve two-year terms, running from July 1 through June 30 of the subsequent year. Director's may serve up to three consecutive terms.
2. Must attend a minimum of three (3) LSAA events and attend 80% of LSAA Board meetings per year. Board meetings are primarily virtual. Dates and times of board meetings are agreed upon by the board to ensure maximum availability and participation. Two board meetings, per year, are in-person.
3. Make a serious commitment to participate actively in LSAA committee work. The LSAA is a working board where each director will serve on a committee.
4. Stays informed about committee matters, is prepared for meetings, and reviews and comments on minutes and reports in advance of meetings.
5. Builds a collegial working relationship with other committee members that contributes to consensus.
6. Participate in the committee's annual evaluation and planning efforts.
7. Participates in the advancement of the strategic plan and Program of Works of the LSAA, including fundraising and member recruitment.
8. Support the current Stockton Leadership program by attending at least one class session per cohort.
9. Director's are required to maintain an active LSAA membership.
